with cones, and

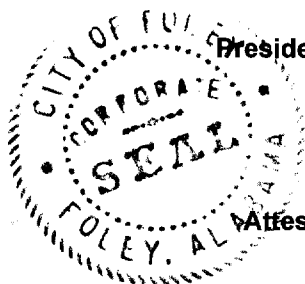
WHEREAS, the money raised will assist in the funding of their state convention and

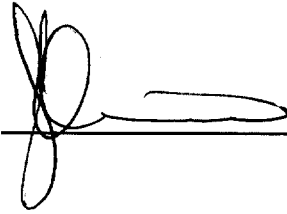
