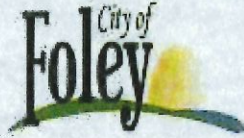

Proclamation

- Whereas,** in the 1980s, Frances U. Lager worked at Baldwin Mutual Insurance Company; and
- Whereas,** she was also a member and officer of the Gayfers Jubilee Career Club made up of 50 career women who lived and worked in Baldwin County. This Club's purpose was to offer professional oriented programs, recognize women's achievements among goals; and
- Whereas,** Frances was also a longtime member of the Performing Arts Association in Foley and at the time she served as chairwoman, the Performing Arts Association boasted 350 members; and
- Whereas,** Mrs. Frances Lager was among selected Election Officials by the Foley City Council in June of 1980; and
- Whereas,** permanent members of the Foley Public Library Board began to be appointed by the Foley City Council in April of 1957; and
- Whereas,** Frances Lager was appointed to the Foley Public Library Board by Foley City Council on June 17, 1985 and served on this Board for 36 years; and
- Now, therefore,** I, Ralph Hellmich, Mayor of the City of Foley, Alabama, and on behalf of the City of Foley City Council, do hereby declare that we take public and official recognition of:

for her long and faithful service to the citizens of this City, and express to her grieving family our sincere appreciation of her dedicated performance of the duties of her office on the Foley Public Library Board and other offices she has held and our deep realization of the loss we have sustained.
