

Below is a list of the City of Foley's FY2020 Planned Projects that are subject to Planning Commission review and recommendation based on Section 11-52-11, Code of Alabama. Please place this item on the November Planning Commission Agenda.

AIRPORT:

201911-1 - Airport Ramp/Taxiway Mill & Repave

Location: Foley Municipal Airport (510 N. Airport Drive)

Estimated Cost: \$635,355, Grant Funding \$603,587 (FAA and ALDOT Aeronautical Bureau grant

funding approved for project - 90% FAA and 5% ALDOT)

Project Description: Remove existing asphalt surface of access taxiways on north apron that is weathered and raveling, excavate embankment and construct a new pavement section capable of supporting aircraft with maximum gross weight of 12,500 lbs.

ENGINEERING:

201911-2 - Pine Street Property Improvements (BOE)

Location: Northwest corner of US98 and Pine Street

Estimated Cost: \$50,000

Project Description: Create an area such as a pocket park to be utilized by the public on the

northwest corner of US98 and Pine Street.

201911-3 - Rose Trail Near Post Office

Location: 90' wide section located between US98 and Orange Avenue west of the Post Office

Estimated Cost: \$150,000

Project Description: Extension of Rose Trail

NATURE PARKS:

• 201911-4 - Outdoor Class Pavilion

Location: Graham Creek Nature Preserve (East of archery park and north of outdoor classroom)

Estimated cost: \$25,000

Project Description: It is planned to build a 20'x20' metal pavilion with concrete floor. This will

service users of both archery park and playground area.

201911-5 - Boardwalk

Location: Graham Creek (About 100 yards west of the kayak launch)

Estimated Cost: \$75,000 (Grant funding through ADCNR is 50% of the project)

Project Description: The boardwalk will begin about 50 yards from the parking area and extend southward along the western edge of the creek where the navigability ends. The boardwalk will end on the south bank of Graham Creek creating a loop trail and additional accessibility. The wooden boardwalk will have handrails where crossing the stream. Total length is 300 feet.

• 201911-6 - Fencing & Storage Area

Location: Fencing is along Wolf Bay Drive on the northern border of the Park. Storage area is located in the previous location of the Wildlife Rehab Center.

Estimated Cost - \$24,000

Project Description: Fencing will be along Wolf bay Drive on the northern border of the park. The Storage area improvements include a new privacy fence (replacing existing fence) where equipment is stored. IF money is left from fencing and gates, there will be an additional awning built to cover the boat and trailers.

PUBLIC WORKS:

• 201911-8 - In-House Road Construction

Location: Wilson Pecan/Farmers Market

Estimated Cost: \$117,840

Project Description: New road will be constructed between CR20 and Kenny Stabler Boulevard

201911-9 – Sidewalk Improvements

Location: Throughout City and at Dog Park

Estimate Cost: \$50,000

Project Description: Existing sidewalks in various locations will be demolished and rebuilt. New

sidewalks will be constructed around the Dog Park.

MULTI-USE FIELDS:

201911-10 – Pole Barn for Equipment Storage

Location: Sports Tourism Maintenance Barn

Estimated Cost: \$10,000

Project Description: Pole barn for storage of golf carts, mowers, etc.








Graham Creek Boardwalk Existing Site Conditions






