WHEREAS, teen drivers ages (16-19) are involved in fatal crashes at four times the rate of adult drivers (25-69); and

WHEREAS, research tells us the high risk factors to teen drivers are inexperience, distractions, speed, driving at night and not buckling up; and

WHEREAS, Foley High School's "Safe Driving" campaign in recognition of National Teen Driver Safety Week 2013 endeavors to help parents and teens reduce the high-risk situations for novice drivers and others all year long; and

WHEREAS, by working together with community partners including Frances Holk-Jones – State Farm, WHEP 1310 AM & 92.5 FM, MADD, and Little Bitty's Towing, we can save teen lives in our community;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mayor John Koniar, do hereby proclaim 18-26, 2013 as **Teen Driver Safety Week** in the City of Foley and I commend this observance to all citizens.
