WHEREAS, United Pentecostal Holiness Church is commemorating its 50th Church Anniversary on March 20, 2022, communities and congregations are coming together to help celebrate this marvelous occasion; and

WHEREAS, in 1972, God gave the church founding Pastor Elder Corinne Powell, an unction to establish a permanent place of worship, being United Pentecostal Holiness Church. Ultimately, the land was purchased and the former gas station-style structure was renovated; and
