Chief, Lt. Fuqua informed after the council approved the 2021 vehicle purchase he contacted the dealership. Lt. Fuqua spoke with the fleet sales manager and was told that they had sold all the Tahoe PPV that was coming in their first order. (which is expected to arrive in April). They are now placing orders for the second round of Tahoe PPV's however the build date is not till August. They advised GM is having trouble with suppliers due to COVID. From talking with other dealers the effects of COVID have impacted Ford Also. Donohoo has 5 Chevy Silverado's on that lot that is on state bid. The price of each Silverado is about \$2K less than the Tahoe PPV. Will we need to go back to the council to ask to change to the Silverado from Tahoe's?
