Proclamation

WHEREAS, it is the goal of all organizations that are involved with the prevention of drug abuse to motivate individuals to become more active participants in programs to eliminate the problem of drug abuse from our community; and

WHEREAS, increasing recognition is being given to the role of family involvement in preventing drug abuse, with the awareness that many of the conditions that contribute to the use of drugs – lack of parental guidance, unacceptable role models, and peer pressure to try drugs – could be mitigated if the family unit were strengthened; and
