E. PROJECT SUMMARY: Briefly summarize the project, including objectives, activities, target populations and anticipated benefits:

Collection Development with a focus on Homeschooling

The Foley Public Library seeks to develop a more comprehensive homeschool resource collection as a means of supplementing the materials already available in our facility. Foley is home to a diverse population many of whom are homeschoolers and patrons of the public library. Many of these parents and children use the Foley Public Library exclusively to find materials needed to fulfill their educational goals. Furthermore, homeschoolers needs tend to vary from those of public school-attending patrons who have access to a much more extensive variety of materials in their formal environment. And, indeed, expense may prevent homeschooling families from providing their children with the same quality and quantity of learning materials traditionally found in the public school system.

The Foley Public Library proposes to develop and collect a wide array of materials needed by the homeschooling community. At present Foley owns a small collection of general homeschooling books housed in the adult non-fiction section. These books will be supplemented with titles that will be suggested by the homeschooling community as well as the library's own staff. Along with general homeschooling books Foley will add to its e-book collection, supplement the periodicals section, and add to the electronic materials that outline some of the more popular homeschooling curriculums.
