REASON:		
Item Nos.1 through 3 - the poor integrity of the existing roadway pavement has caused cracking and pavement failures along the excavation for each planned lateral. The Contractor has used care and it is in the best interest of the project to replace the asphalt at each location back to sound pavement. Item No. 4 - Existing conditions will not require gutter replacement. Item No. 5 - Add additional discovered laterals discovered during the course of construction. Item Nos.6 and 7 - Once the cleaning of the manholes started it was discovered that there were some significant I/I defects and evidence of microbial-induced concrete corrosion in these manholes. Originally it was thought that they only needed to have their leaking joints and chimneys sealed, but the cleaning revealed these unforeseen defects. Item No. 8 - due to the existing conditions after cleaning, this item will not be needed. Item No.9 - The additional Highway 59 laterals are all at inopportune locations - underneath entrances to businesses, underneath large concrete slabs, underneath existing storm drain inlet boxes, underneath fiber optic lines, etc. The existing pay item is the best method to make these repairs.
