Dear David,

As requested, we are pleased to offer the following quotation for the work to be performed on the four existing tennis courts at City Park located in Foley.

We have inspected the tennis court fencing and determined the following scope of work.

For the price of \$11,896.00, we will:

1. Remove the existing fence fabric (except on the single walk gates) and the double drive gate and haul off
2. Straighten (1) leaning light pole (70 degree on the north end)
3. Realign (4) single lights
4. Reinstall (2) loop caps and one rail
5. Rebuild the Double Drive gate
6. Replace (1) single gate header rail
7. Adjust (1) mid rail
8. Install (1) new dome cap
9. Install new 9 gauge fence fabric and hardware
10. Install (1) net and center strap
11. Install (2) new rollers on the Rol-Dri units

Adequate access and water must be made available to the site. All labor and materials will have a one (1) year warranty. This quotation does not include the construction of or the repair of any landscaping, sidewalks, irrigation work, electrical work, etc. All debris must be removed from the court prior to work commencing.
