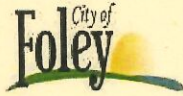

Proclamation

- Whereas,** We are here today to express special recognition to Robert D. Schreiber, Sr. and to honor him for his distinguished twenty-plus year career serving on the Foley City Council and the Riviera Utilities Board, and his dedicated service to the residents of the City of Foley, and;
- Whereas,** Robert Schreiber, Sr. began his career serving 20 years in the Marine Corps. He attended Flight School becoming a Naval Aviator. He served a tour in Japan and later became a trained helicopter pilot serving in the Vietnam War. His USMC awards and citations include: Outstanding Company Grade of Aviators from three squadrons, the Distinguished Flying Cross, a Purple Heart, an Air Medal W 280 Missions, a Combat Action Ribbon and the Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry, among many others, and;
- Whereas,** Robert D. Schreiber, Sr. went on to earn his Master's Degree in Education from South Alabama receiving the Outstanding Student Award. He taught 5th and 6th graders in Elberta, earning the Outstanding Teacher of the Year Award in his third year teaching school. He taught the girl's middle school basketball team taking them on to win a division championship. Making his residence here in Foley he worked for Mr. John Foley, Magnolia Land Company, he also worked in construction, land development, rental properties, timber and land management, and;
- Whereas,** Robert D. Schreiber, Sr. dutifully served as a member of the City of Foley Library Board. He also served as a City Council Member for the City of Foley on two different occasions between the years of 1984 - 2008. While serving on the City Council he played an instrumental role in working with the Alabama Department of Transportation on the expansion of Highway 59 from a two-lane highway to the four-lane highway we see today, and;
- Whereas,** Robert D. Schreiber, Sr. was appointed by the Foley City Council to serve on the Riviera Utilities Board of the City of Foley (the Board) on October 1, 2005, and served with distinction and honor as both a Director and past Chairman through April 30, 2024, helping to guide the organization to an upgraded rating of credit worthiness, and financial operational stability, and;
- Whereas,** Robert D. Schreiber, Sr. is a Member of Morgan's Chapel United Methodist Church, where he volunteers in the local Food Ministry serving 80 - 120 families each week. He has been married for nearly 54 years to Mrs. Mary Rush and they share a son, Rob, they also share two daughters by his late wife Fran, Valerie, and his late daughter, Cindy. He also has four grandchildren, Dylan, Nicholas, Cory, and Eric, and;
- Whereas,** On behalf of the entire City Council, I want to express our sincere appreciation to Bob for his loyalty and dedication to the City of Foley and wish him and his family much happiness.
