

Website Infrastructure: This proposal from CivicPlus to completely overhaul our digital presence. This project transitions our current web infrastructure into a modern, interconnected network featuring a primary municipal website and four department-specific sub-sites for the Fire Department, Police Department, Parks & Recreation, and Public Library.

Content Management System (CMS): The new system grants individual departments the ability to manage their own content, calendars, and resources independently. This eliminates current administrative bottlenecks and publication delays, ensuring timely and accurate information is provided directly to the public while maintaining a unified city brand.

CivicReady Portal: This platform introduces critical communication capabilities that the City does not currently have in place. It allows the City to send news alerts, routine updates, and emergency messaging to residents via text message, email, and automated voice calls, and it includes geotargeting features for area-specific messaging.

DOJ & ADA Compliance: The new network will be fully compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act. This proactively meets the new Department of Justice digital accessibility mandates scheduled to go into effect in 2028.
