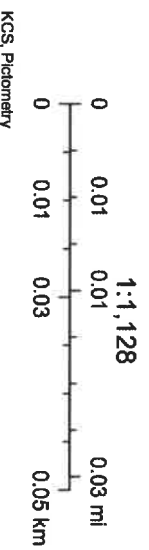

Dear Sir/Madam:

A complaint has been received concerning weeds and overgrown vegetation creating a potential public nuisance at S Hickory ST, Foley, Alabama. This parcel is further described as PIN# 294994 on the Baldwin County Tax Maps.

In accordance with City of Foley Ordinance No. 1095-09, *Clearing and Maintenance of Lots that Constitute a Public Nuisance*, Section 4-104 states that a nuisance may be declared when grass and weeds which bear seeds of a wingy or downy nature, which attain a large growth so as to become a fire menace when dry, or otherwise noxious or dangerous. Private property owners should take regular steps to maintain the property in a manner to prevent the nuisance.

A visual inspection conducted on 04/14/2026 revealed that the above-referenced property contained weeds and grass exceeding twelve (12) inches in height, which may constitute a public nuisance. Please be advised that, as of the date of this letter, you are hereby placed on notice to correct this violation within ten (10) days of receipt. Failure to comply may result in a City Council resolution declaring the weeds, grass, and other vegetation to be a public nuisance and ordering abatement of the nuisance following a public hearing.
