

- Whereas,** she has assisted in the selection of high school seniors to receive scholarships in the arts over the decades; and
- Whereas,** she has organized countless receptions for featured artists, civic concerts for the public and Snow Bird Receptions; and
- Whereas,** she was a driving force in supporting funding for an art teacher at Foley Elementary School in the 1980s before the Baldwin County Board of Education provided the program; and
- Whereas,** Linda promoted bringing Poetry Alive to eleven South Baldwin Schools to provide live actors performing poetry to students; and
- Whereas,** on the 50th Anniversary of Art in the Park, May 7, 2022, the new pocket park by the Foley Art Center was dedicated to Linda Koniar for her many years of exceptional service in support of cultural enrichment for South Baldwin County.
