Discuss Plans For New Foley Elementary School

Baldwin County Board of Education Superintendent Eddie Tyler introduced Frank Boatwright, who presented the attached site plan drawings for the new Foley elementary school to be built on the 9th Avenue extension.

Mr. Boatwright reported the new building will face south and it will consist of approximately 112,000 square feet with fifty three (53) classrooms.

He reported there is a tentative bid date of March 22, 2018 and the targeted completion date is July, 2019.

Mayor Koniar asked if there will be security measures built into the new school. Mr. Boatwright explained that there will be only one point of entrance into the building at the administrative office then once checked in, people will be buzzed in. The school doors will be secured.

Police Chief David Wilson asked how much glass will be in the exterior doors. Mr. Barganier reported all the exterior glass and the glass in the vestibule will be impact glass. All exterior windows and doors will have impact glass.

There was discussion on the tornado shelter that will be located in the center of the building. The tornado shelter is indicated in the shaded area of the attached A1.0 drawing.

There was discussion on parent pick up and drop off points.
