Dear Mayor and Council,

The South Baldwin Chamber of Commerce requests permission to hold a one day festival, Alabama Festival of Flavor, in the streets of Historic Downtown Foley on Saturday, October 18th.

We are asking for closure of the downtown Foley streets beginning at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, October 17 and not reopen until 10:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 18. Closure of the following streets is requested: Orange Avenue between Johnston & Daniel to the west and Hwy 59 to the east, Alston Street from Hwy 98 to the north and just south of **Verbena Avenue**. Please see enclosed map.

In addition, we are asking for closure of Hwy 98 from Hwy 59 to Alston between the hours 4 p.m. and 10 p.m. on Saturday, October 18th. The chamber is requesting permission to use the parking lot near Wright Pharmacy for this same time period.

The festival will encompass this entire area beginning at 4:00 p.m. Friday, October 17 and concluding at 10:00 p.m. Saturday, October 18. It is imperative for the success and safety of our festival guests and participants to secure closure of the requested streets.

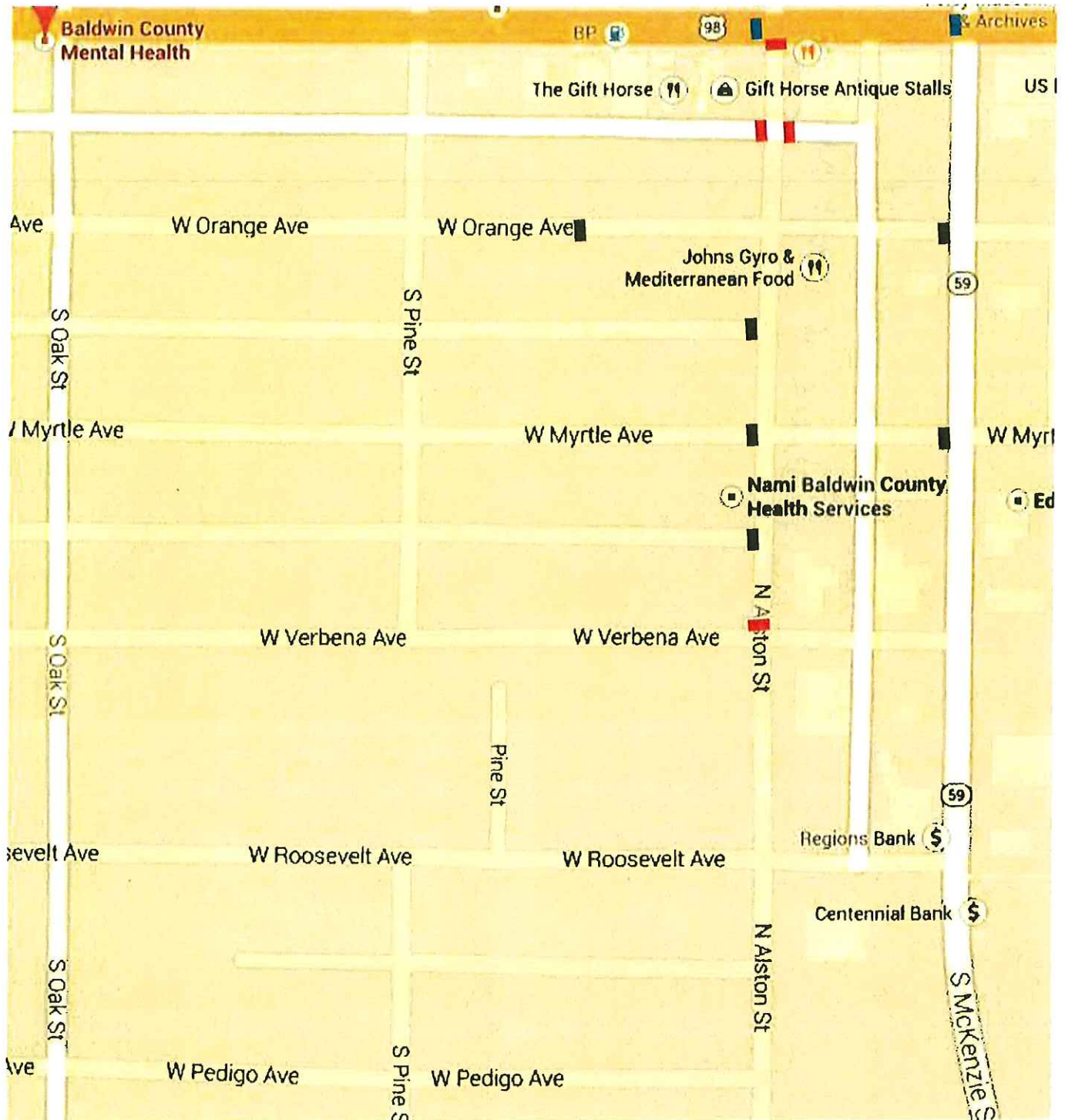
