2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 To propose an amendment to the Constitution of
4 Alabama of 1901, to allow mayors in Baldwin County to
5 participate in the Employees' Retirement System.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. The following amendment to the
8 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become
9 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of
10 this act are fulfilled:

11 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

12 In Baldwin County, mayors of municipalities that
13 participate in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama may
14 participate in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama
15 upon the same terms and conditions as may be specified by law
16 for any other employee in the same retirement system. A mayor
17 holding office at the time of the ratification of this
18 amendment shall be eligible to purchase service credit in the
19 Employees' Retirement System for the time the official has
20 served in the current office. No person may participate in
21 both a supernumerary program and the Employees' Retirement
22 System based on the same service.

23 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
24 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the
25 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section

1 284.01 of the Official ReCompilation of the Constitution of
2 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
3 state.

4 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
5 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
6 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
7 following description of the substance or subject matter of
8 the proposed constitutional amendment:

9 "Relating to Baldwin County, proposing an amendment
10 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to allow mayors to
11 participate in the Employees' Retirement System.

12 "Proposed by Act _____."

13 This description shall be followed by the following
14 language:

15 "Yes () No ()."
