

## Proclamation

- Whereas, Mr. Eddie Tyler has served as the Superintendent of Baldwin County Public Schools since September 17, 2015; and
- Whereas, Mr. Tyler and his senior staff determined that reducing overcrowding in the Foley feeder pattern was a top priority and because of this, we now have the addition of Florence B. Mathis Elementary; and
- Whereas, Mr. Tyler has provided stellar leadership through the COVID-19 pandemic; and
- Whereas, Once schools were permitted to open, Mr. Tyler allowed students and parents to choose either returning to school or continue with virtual learning. Teachers were not required to teach both, instead there were virtual school teachers and brick and mortar teachers, which was a tremendous help with strain due to the pandemic; and
- Whereas, Mr. Tyler remained committed to in-person learning as he knew how important structure is to children and their development and he never wavered, even though there were many critics; and
- Whereas, Mr. Tyler, along with the Baldwin County Board of Education, unanimously agreed that all full-time employees be given a \$1,000 bonus; and
- Whereas, Mr. Tyler knew the importance of the COVID-19 vaccines in the fight against the virus and ensured that teachers and staff received the vaccine and also made sure they did not have to use their personal or sick time to get vaccinated; and
- Whereas, Mr. Tyler continues to stress the importance of partnerships, and remains committed to developing strong relationships with local municipalities such as the City of Foley.

Now, therefore, be it proclaimed by the Foley City Council and Mayor Ralph Hellmich that


