The Engineer hereby agrees to provide professional services during the construction of this project as follows: The scope and fee represent part time limited inspection services.

- Review laboratory, mill and shop test to assist in monitoring the quality of construction.
- 2. Consult and advise during construction.
- 3. Provide services of resident project representative (RPR) for onsite inspection and engineering during construction.
- 4. Review monthly and final estimates for payment to Contractors.
- 5. Make final inspection of the construction upon completion.

SCHEDULE - Work will be scheduled upon receipt of authorization and will continue until complete.

FEE - Fees will be billed monthly on an hourly basis, in accordance with rates shown on the attached Fee Schedule. It is expressly agreed and stipulated between the parties that this contract shall be deemed to have been made in the State of Alabama where the principal office of Volkert, Inc. is located. This contract shall be governed by the laws of the State of Alabama. The Circuit or District Court of Mobile, Alabama shall have jurisdiction over any dispute which arises under this contract, and each of the parties shall submit and hereby consents to the jurisdiction of either such court.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Engineer shall perform the services outlined in this agreement for the stated fee agreement.

<u>Access to Site</u> - Unless otherwise stated, the ENGINEER and his agents will have access to the site for activities necessary for the performance of the services specified in this agreement.

<u>Billings/Payments</u> - Partial payments for all services performed by the Consultant under the terms of the Agreement shall be made no more often than monthly to the Consultant by the Owner upon receipt of invoices and other evidence of performance. Payments shall be due and payable within thirty (30) days of the date of invoice. The Consultant reserves the right to stop all work if payment is not received within thirty (30) days. In addition to the monthly progress payments, final payment for each deliverable is required at the time of its delivery

If a Deposit is required on the contract it will be held by the Consultant and applied to the final billings on this contract.

Amounts unpaid thirty (30) days after the invoice date shall bear interest at the rate of one and one-half (1-1/2%) per month. Amounts unpaid after one hundred twenty (120) days will automatically be referred to professional collection services. Owner shall reimburse Consultant for any expenses, including legal costs, incurred in collection of outstanding amounts due from Owner.

Risk Allocation - In recognition of the relative risks, rewards and benefits of the project to both the Client and the ENGINEER, the risks have been allocated so that the Client agrees that, to the fullest extent permitted by law, the ENGINEER's total liability to the Client, for any and all injuries, claims, losses, expenses, damages or claim expenses arising out of this agreement, from an cause or causes, shall not exceed the total amount of \$50,000, the amount of the ENGINEER's fee (whichever is greater), or other amount agreed upon when added under special conditions. Such causes include, but are not limited to the ENGINEER's negligence, errors, omissions, strict liability, breach of contract or breach of warranty.

<u>Termination of Services</u> - This agreement may be terminated upon ten (10) days written notice by either party should the other fail to perform his obligations hereunder. In the event of termination, the Client shall pay the ENGINEER for all services rendered to the date of termination, all reimbursable expenses, and reimbursable termination expenses.

Ownership of Documents - All original papers and documents, and copies thereof, produced as a result of this contract, except documents which are required to be filed with public agencies, shall remain the property of the Engineer and may be used by the Engineer without the consent of the client.

Facsimile Signatures - Facsimile signatures shall be sufficient unless originals are required by a third party.

<u>Applicable Law</u> - Unless otherwise specified, this agreement shall be governed by the laws of the principal place of business of the ENGINEER.

PAYMENT TO VOLKERT IS NOT CONTINGENT UPON OWNER RECEIVING FINANCING OF THIS PROJECT. IF PAYMENT FOR INVOICES IS NOT RECEIVED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF RECEIPT, ALL WORK EFFORTS WILL STOP AND WILL NOT RESUME UNTIL PAYMENTS ARE MADE CURRENT.
