Marketing Department Annual Report

Overview:

2019 was a strong year for leisure tourism in Foley. Visitors report they enjoy the friendly people, small shops and diverse dining options they find in Foley. The word is out that this is a great place to spend a day while at the beach.

Overall, for the year, visitor numbers were up. Visitor counts at the Welcome Center totaled 5,948, which was down five percent from 2018. Visitor counts at the Holmes Medical Museum totaled 8,920, which was up by 31.4 percent from 2018. Visitor counts at the Depot Museum hit 17,832, which is up 62 percent over fiscal year 2018. The total visitor count at the model trains was 26,356, which is down 4 percent from the previous year. This sounds like mixed results, but the increases were so large that this year's totals equals the most visitors we have seen in the downtown area.

Other significant happenings, by month are detailed below:

October: Due to forecasted bad weather, the city Halloween event was held in Heritage Park. It was very well attended in spite of changing the date and the venue at the last minute.

December: On Dec. 8, Foley's Christmas Parade rolled in spite of scattered rain, but Let is Snow was rescheduled on Dec. 15.

January: Over 600 guests attended the annual snowbird coffee, sponsored jointly by the South Baldwin Chamber of Commerce and the city.

With assistance from the Museum Archives Board, staff began collecting oral histories from older residents with an emphasis on gathering stories about the depot and the trains that once came to Foley.

Sherry Sullivan was named Foley's first Main Street Director.

February – Welcome Center and museum employees attended the Alabama Museum Association conference in Montgomery.

Public Works ordered 100 pink garbage cans and they were all spoken for on the first day they were released to the public.

March: Foley's Mardi Gras Parade brought a lot of visitors to downtown Foley on Saturday, March 2.

April – Foley had 98 total participants during the four Saturday walking tours offered in April. The tours, which last one hour and begin at 10 a.m., were led by local experts that included Judge Tim Russell and his wife Sandy, Deborah Mixon, Zana Price and David Dalton.

May – The Wilbourne Rose Trail was one of eight locations featured on the Baldwin County Master Gardener's spring garden tour, which included gardens in Foley and Magnolia Springs. Perry Wilbourne was available to answer questions about the roses and the trail during the tour.

June – June concluded another year of Music and a Movie in the Park. The popular series is attended by hundreds of people, mostly families, during Fridays in the spring. Prior to that event, goods are available from vendors in the park for the Heritage Park Marketplace. Several hundred people usually attend this event prior to the movie.

July – Public Parking signs were placed in designated spots around the heart of downtown Foley.

August - Attended the Governor's Conference on Tourism in Huntsville, Alabama

September – Alabama Archives Department staff traveled to Foley to provide training to welcome center and museum employees on basics of curating and storing for museums. They gave both of Foley's museums good marks based on overall management for small museums statewide.
