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## Miflin Road Phase 1 Access Management Plan:

### **Timeline:**

- 2017- Council funded the development of the AMP by Skipper Consulting
- 2019-Council adopted the draft plan to guide development.
- 2020-Council funded design by Baskerville - Donovan, Inc.
- 2020-2025: Plan creation and critical step completion of Juniper Street Extension, Service Road connection, and median improvements on AL 59 north of CR 20.

### **Project Scope:**

- Project is in FY 26 capital plan and design and plans are ready to bid.
- Project consists of removing existing asphalt median lane along Miflin Road from AL-59 to Juniper Street for Phase 1, and returning with grass median, median lighting, and concrete curbing along median edge.
- There will be a “mid-block” u-turn capability within 1,000’ from AL 59, providing Miflin Road cross over traffic alternatives to AL 59.
- Multiple proposed access points onto Miflin Road are designed to be converted into “right-in / right-out” to correspond with the open median.
- The work is scheduled to take place “under traffic” with minor lane closures. This will include using orange & white channelizing drums, flaggers, message boards, etc. Full closure of Miflin Road is not anticipated, nor desired.
- City will utilize social media and other news outlets to inform citizens of the upcoming project closer to construction start date, and routine progress throughout construction as necessary, with emphasis on business openness.
- Anticipated project timeframe would be 3-4 months.
- Key milestones have been completed for this project to move forward, including:
  - Completion of Juniper Street Extension from AL 59 to Miflin Rd., including new signal and signal upgrades.
  - Completion of “Palm Beach Way”
  - Design of “mid-block” u-turn capability
