ESTABLISHING A SENIOR CITIZENS BOARD**

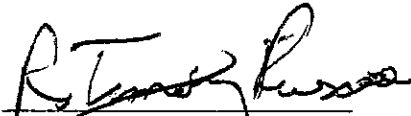
WHEREAS, on October 1, 1979, a Senior Citizens Advisory Board for the City of Foley, Alabama, was established and provided for five members, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intention of the Mayor and Council to increase the membership to include two voting members to the Board.

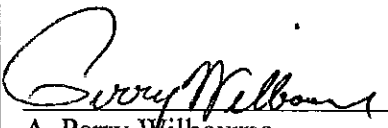
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Foley, Alabama:

- Section 1: That the Foley Senior Citizens Advisory Board for the City of Foley, Alabama, heretofore established shall continue in its original capacity.
- Section 2. This resolution shall amend the Resolution adopted October 1, 1979 to include two new voting members.
- Section 3. The term of the new voting members shall run for a period of three years upon which time the member can be reappointed or re-selection can be done at the discretion of the Council.

According to the enabling Resolution dated October 1, 1979 there is no set number of members to be appointed to serve on the Senior Citizen Advisory Board. The original Board was created by the Mayor and Council, appointing five (5) members to serve.
