Dear Honorable Mayor Koniar,

Sawgrass Consulting, LLC, (Sawgrass) has been asked to provide additional services for survey, design and inspection to repair a third outfall location, Outfall "C", in Graham Creek Estates; see Exhibit A. The original scopes of services for this project included the design the repair two storm water outfall locations as directed by the City Engineer as described in Resolution No. 14-0146-RES. The additional scope is noted below:

Survey and Design

At the time of the field evaluation and with additional video inspection of the storm sewer pipes, it was discovered that a third deficient outfall pipe (Outfall "C") along Bay View Drive leading to Graham Creek needed repairs. The physical address of this outfall is between 8072 and 8068 Bay View Drive. Since the contracted design had not reached 100% status, Sawgrass will incorporate the design of an additional drainage section and associated details within the construction plan set. See the supplemental agreement manpower estimate for these services.

Inspection and Construction Testing Services

Due to the sensitive nature of the repairs, their proximity to existing residences and the conditions set within the final drainage easement agreements with the POA, the City Engineering Department has requested that Sawgrass provide more of a daily presence during the construction phase of this project. In addition, the proposal of the third outfall repair will essentially increase the scope and effort by one-third, which directly impacts construction cost and time. See the supplemental agreement manpower estimate for these services.

Construction Testing was not part of the original scope of services due the unknown approach of repair and materials. This fee has been included in the supplemental agreement and is a part of Attachment B.
