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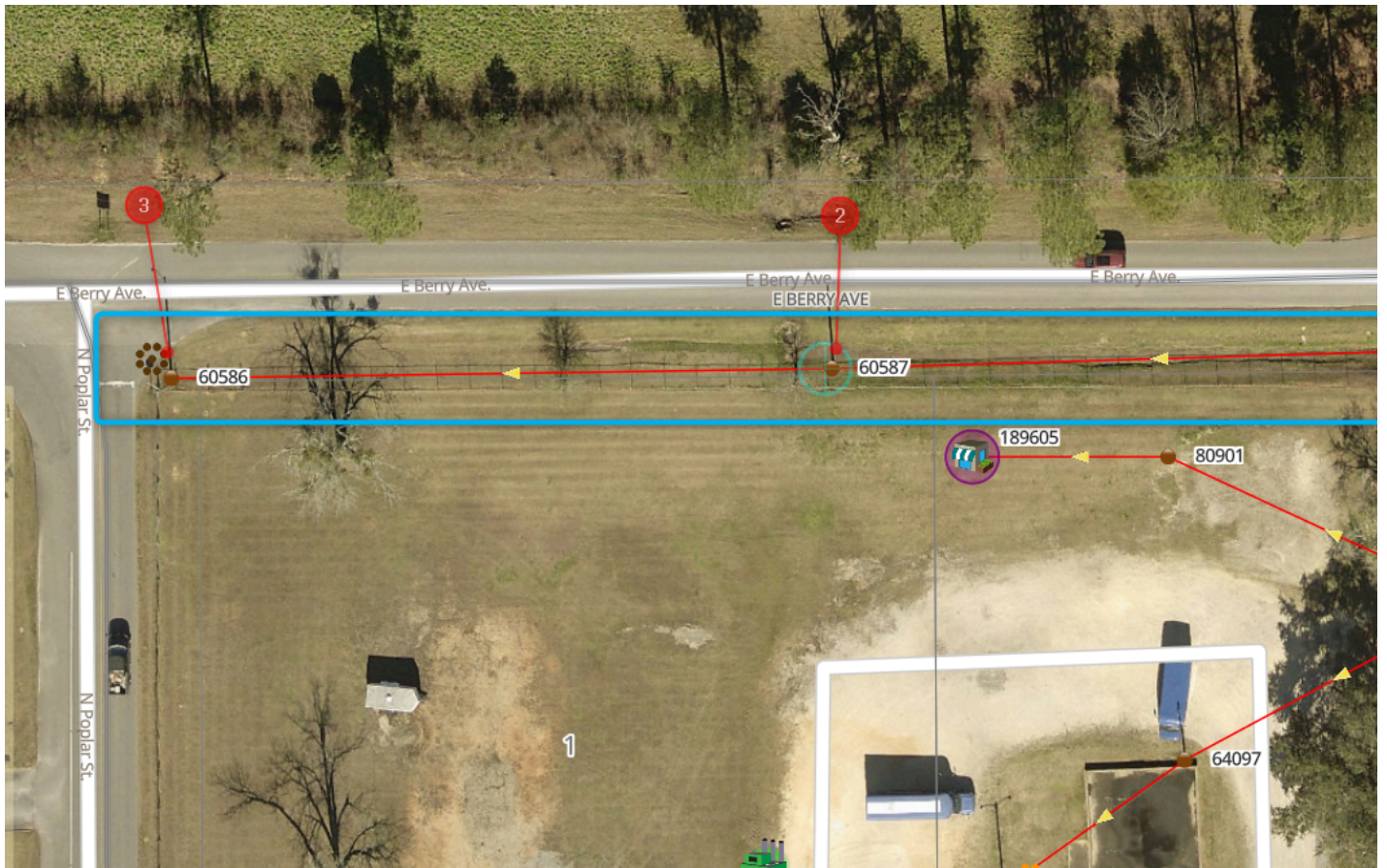

Taylor/Buford,

We will be burying the light circuit along Berry between Juniper and Poplar to eliminate a light circuit lift pole (2) that is currently in the way of the Safe Room facility entrance. Our current poles/fixtures are at either corner of the block (1 & 3). In this process, would you - A.) like for us to add a new decorative style light pole to shine over Berry near the new entrance? and B.) like for us to add decorative style light poles/fixtures at locations 1 & 3 to decorative style light poles/fixtures?

The City would only be responsible for the light pole/fixture install costs; Riviera will be covering the circuit install costs. The poles/fixtures would be black decorative 35' aluminum breakaway poles along HWY 59. These would be \$1500 ea to install and 18.50/month ea. We would take away the monthly rate of any we replace, of course. The current light poles at the intersections are 18' ea.
