WHEREAS, the Train Depot Museum has a request to go to bid and purchase a new trackless train, and

WHEREAS, the Museum Board has approved up to \$23,000 from account 01-1069 to go towards the engine and accesories, and

WHEREAS, the Museum Board has approved to request sponsorships through the South Baldwin Chamber

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Foley, Alabama, as follows:

SECTION 1: Approves advertising going to bid for a new trackless train.

SECTION 2: Approves purchasing a new trackless train in the amount of up to \$53,000.

SECTION 2: Appropriates up to \$23,000 towards the purchase of the engine and accesories and ammends account 623-7010.

SECTION 3: Approves contacting the South Baldwin Chamber to request sponsorships.

SECTION 4: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption as required by law.
