

to employ an unauthorized alien within the State of Alabama. Furthermore, a contracting party found to be in violation of this provision shall be deemed in breach of the agreement and shall be responsible for all damages resulting therefrom. The CONTRACTOR and all sub-contractors shall demonstrate proof of enrollment in the E-Verify System. 102.23 STATE OF ALABAMA LICENSING REQUIREMENTS

Any person, firm or corporation not being duly authorized who shall engage in the business of general contracting in this state, except as provided for in this chapter, and any person, frim or corporation presenting or attempting to file as its own the license certificate of another, or who shall give false or forged evidence of any kind to the board, or to any member thereof, in obtaining a certificate of license, or who falsely shall impersonate another, or who shall use an expired or revoked certificate of license, and any person including an owner, architect or engineer who receives or considers a bid from any one not properly licensed under this chapter, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall for each offense of which he is convicted be punished by a fine of not less than \$500.00 or imprisonment of six months, or both fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court. The submission of the contractor's current license number before considering the bid shall be sufficient evidence to relieve the owner, architect or engineer of the awarding authority of any liability under this chapter.
