The cost to make changes is as follows:

- Install 6" thick sidewalk approaches per supplemental drawing SK-1, dated 5/14/13. Install single decorative stamped soldier course brick pattern band at edge of gazebo slab and sidewalks. Add monotone stained and sealed finish to sidewalks and edge band. Install PVC conduit under slab to center of steel gazebo column and pull MC 12/3 wire through steel structure to center of structure.

WHEREAS, a gazebo on the Rose Trail is in need of either repair or replacement, and WHEREAS, E-J Builder's submitted two proposals. The first proposal in the amount of \$12,325 was to repair the gazebo with the same materials as currently constructed. The second proposal in the amount of \$20,990 to construct a new 16' wide octagonal shaped pavilion built with concrete and prefabricated steel and a metal shake style roof.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Foley City Council, Foley, Alabama as follows:
SECTION 1: Accepts E-J Builder's proposal in the amount of \$20,990 for the construction of a new octagonal pavilion on the Rose Trail.
