<u>15-0503</u> American Legion's request to continue their turkey shoot

A motion was made by Council Member Ralph Hellmich to approve the American Legion annual turkey shoot from September 2015 through April 2016 once a month using shotguns only provided they move the firing line forward according to the location set forth by the Foley Police Chief. The approval is dependent upon the growth surrounding the American Legion and if at any time the growth moves within 200 yards down range of the firing line this approval becomes null and void in order to keep the public safe from harm or danger. At that time the American Legion will either need to select a different location to hold the turkey shoot fundraiser or elect to hold a different fundraiser at its current location. The American Legion will return in September 2016 to request permission for the turkey shoot to be held once a month beginning September 2016 through April 2017. The motion was seconded by Council Member Rick Blackwell and carried by an unanimous vote.
