Mayor's Comments

Mayor Hellmich congratulated Foley Main Street on a great annual report and on the many new openings of businesses around downtown Foley.

Mayor Hellmich commended Public Works, Fire and Police Departments for a job well done maintaining the City during the snow storm.

He reported that the City will hold a groundbreaking for the new Public Library Thursday, January 30, 2025 at 11:00am.

He also congratulated Environmental Director Leslie Gahagan on the yearly Wolf Bay Watershed Meeting.

Mayor Hellmich reported that the City revenues are down and that they plan to look to see what revenue increases the City has had that may offset it and that the City will be monitoring it closely.

City Administrator Mike Thompson reported that what may be attributing to the decrease in revenues may be the down turn to more normal rates for building permits and plan reviews. He reported that sales tax and lodge tax did not

grow as much as the 6 and 7 percent from the previous two years but we are still even.
