

RESOLUTION NO. 13-0014

APPROVING ATRIP FUNDING PARTICIPATION WITH BALDWIN COUNTY

WHEREAS, the City of Foley approves Resolution 13-0014, approves the Baldwin County Commission and Baldwin County Highway Department to prepare and submit an application for ATRIP Phase 2 funding, and

WHEREAS, Baldwin County Commission is ready to partner with the City for improvements on County Road 20 between Alabama Highway 59 and South Hickory Street, and

WHEREAS, if the project is approved by the State, and upon completion of the project, the City will assume maintenance cost, activities, etc. of this portion of roadway, and

WHEREAS, the construction estimate for the project, including construction, design, environmental, and CE&I is \$1,629,974.00

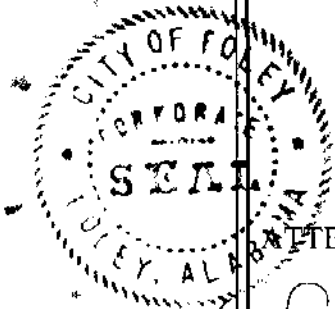
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the City Council of the City of Foley, Alabama, as follows:

SECTION 1: If approved by the State, approves ATRIP funding participation with the City's in the amount of \$263,672 and if approved by the State, Baldwin County's portion to be provided in Fiscal Year 2014 in the amount of \$195,000.00 for County Road 20 improvements between Alabama 59 and South Hickory Street.

SECTION 2: If approved by the State, the Baldwin County Commission will be the lead agency and the City of Foley will provide the Baldwin County Commission funding in Fiscal Year 2013, in the amount of \$165,846.00 for the Preliminary Engineering to be performed by Volkert.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption as required by law.

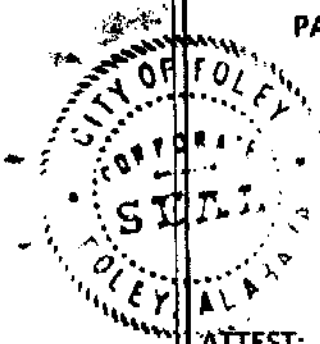

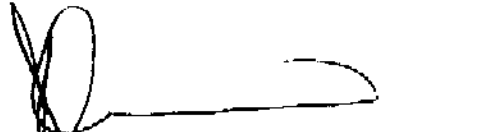
