If the applicant has employees, workers' compensation insurance must be obtained and is subject to Alabama's statutory limits. The applicant also agrees to endorse the City of Foley (City of Foley, Alabama, Attn: Special Events Division, P.O. Box 1750, Foley, AL 36535) as an additional insured on the general liability, auto, and liquor liability policy and to include a copy of each endorsement with the certificate of insurance. Proof of insurance, acceptable to the City, shall be furnished no later than five (5) days preceding the date of the assembly. Failure to provide proof of insurance will automatically revoke permit. Each certificate of insurance shall provide that the insurer must give the City of Foley at least twenty-one (21) days' prior written notice of cancellation and termination of the applicant's coverage there under.

Applications will not be accepted less than 21 days before an Event Date. All vendors participating in events must have a business license or special event license.

Utilities Plan

The utilities provided on site will be sufficient for the needs of this event. There will be no need for a licensed electrician.

There will be at least (2) American Red Cross First Aid Kits in case of incident or life threatening emergency. All volunteers working this event will have a two-way radio for prompt communication across the event location so that any issues are immediately known and can be addressed expeditiously. Should inclement weather arise, the event will be rescheduled and staff, volunteers, and the community will be notified via phone, email, and social media.

Medical Plan

There will be at least (2) American Red Cross First Aid Kits, in case of incident or life threatening emergency. 911 will be phoned immediately, should any incident arise that requires medical, police, or fire department assistance. All volunteers working this event will have a two-way radio for prompt communication across the event location so that any issues are immediately known and can be addressed expeditiously.
