Wayne/Mayor,

What are your thoughts on the below? The good news is that we were able to add some additional roads over in Beulah without exceeding our budgeted amount. I think yesterday Vera mentioned about how much better it all looked.

What Chad is saying is that they lack just 2 roads over there and he would like to get them done as well, but it would cost \$45k of which Riviera is donating \$10k because a lot of these roads had lateral replacements which were not done well and had sunk over time, so the net to the city would be \$35k. I think that if you are ok in them overrunning by \$35k, we would bring to council for memorialized approval at the next meeting because this would be after the fact as the pavers are out there till tomorrow and we would need to give them the ok. No issue on the bid because it is below the criteria of the allowable overrun percentage.

Mike, we had some excess quantities remaining in the Resurfacing project so we have been in the Beulah area paving the park loop and repairing the poorly patched areas from sewer lateral repair. We have totally repaved all of the streets in the vicinity except for E Jackson and S Chestnut. We can bring the project in at budget (\$798K) and still repair the remaining "bad" patches.

For an overage of around \$45K we can fully repave Jackson and Chestnut and repair the patches also. Riviera has agreed to contribute \$10,000 so the overrun to the City would be around \$35K or around 4.5% of the contract. Thoughts?
