

- Defined: Aggregate food together from all size farms to sort, size, grade, wash, prepare and box/package for distribution.
 - Location : In 'Peavy building' next to Gulf Coast Produce.
 - Purpose: To offer farm services for food to be prepared for local supply chain to schools, hospitals, restaurants and other markets.

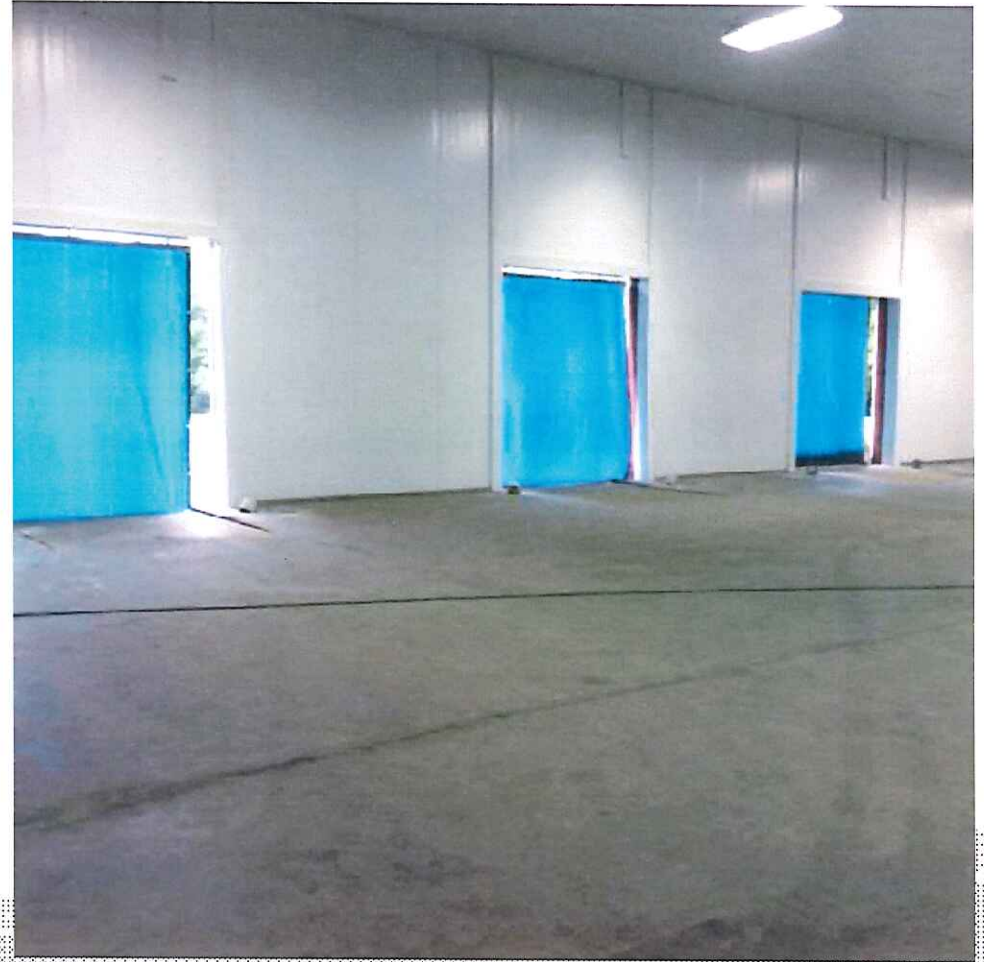
