An EAP program is a confidential assessment, counseling and referral service for all regular employees and their eligible dependents that need help in any of the following areas:

The counselor can also determine the best alternatives and, if necessary, make appropriate referrals to other professionals who specialize in particular areas. *EAP address everyday living problems, NOT clinical diagnoses such as depression, anxiety, abuse, childhood trauma, chemical dependency, and other serious disorders which are covered under the Mental Health Benefits below.*
