Re: Request to Reduce Speed Limit in Wolf Bay Point Subdivision

Dear Mayor and Members of the Foley City Council,

On behalf of the Wolf Bay Point Subdivision, we respectfully request that the City of Foley consider lowering the posted speed limit within Wolf Bay Point Subdivision from 30 mph to 20 mph.

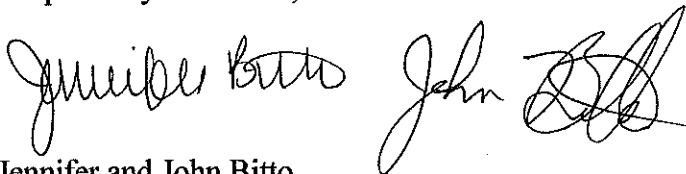
Wolf Bay Point is a residential neighborhood with multiple active members of the community utilizing the roads as walkers, runners, cyclists, caretaker walks with handicap/wheelchair residents, dog walkers and children frequently enjoying the neighborhood. Reducing the speed limit to 20 mph would help promote safer travel conditions and better support the residential and active character of our neighborhood.

There is currently one posted speed limit sign at the entrance to the neighborhood indicating a speed limit of 30 mph. If approved, this one sign would need to be replaced to reflect the new 20 mph speed limit.

We respectfully request that this change be considered and completed during the current budgeted year.

Our neighborhood is unique, in the aspect that we do not have a Property Owners Association or Homeowners Association, we only have an architectural review committee for each half of the neighborhood for new home builds. We, Jennifer and John Bitto have discussed with multiple neighbors the need for a decrease from our current listed speed limit of 30 mph. We have had tremendous support in moving forward with this request from multiple current homeowners. There is history behind the arrival of the 30 mph speed limit sign in Wolf Bay Point Subdivision in recent years, as we never had a posted speed limit sign prior to roughly 2020, when the 30 mph speed limit sign arrived. At that point in time, we as a neighborhood feel the safety of our roads in our neighborhood drastically decreased.
