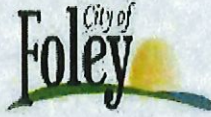

- Whereas, a request for donated books was issued in May 1923 to begin a Foley Public Library via the Foley Women's Club, and;
- Whereas, the first permanent building for the Foley Public Library was opened to the public on May 2, 1927, and;
- Whereas, the Foley Public Library will host a Centennial Celebration on May 3, 2023, and;
- Whereas, the Foley Public Library is an integral part of the community providing over 88,000 items to check out, an active computer lab, an expansive local Alabama history and genealogy department, an engrossing Children's area as well as many educational and entertaining programs for young and old alike, and;
- Whereas, our library continues to grow with a new library scheduled to be built in the near future due to a growing need for space, storage and programming areas.

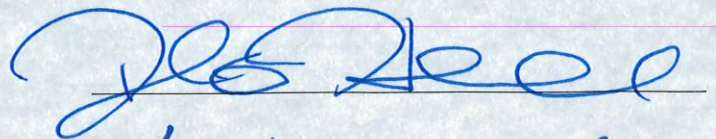
