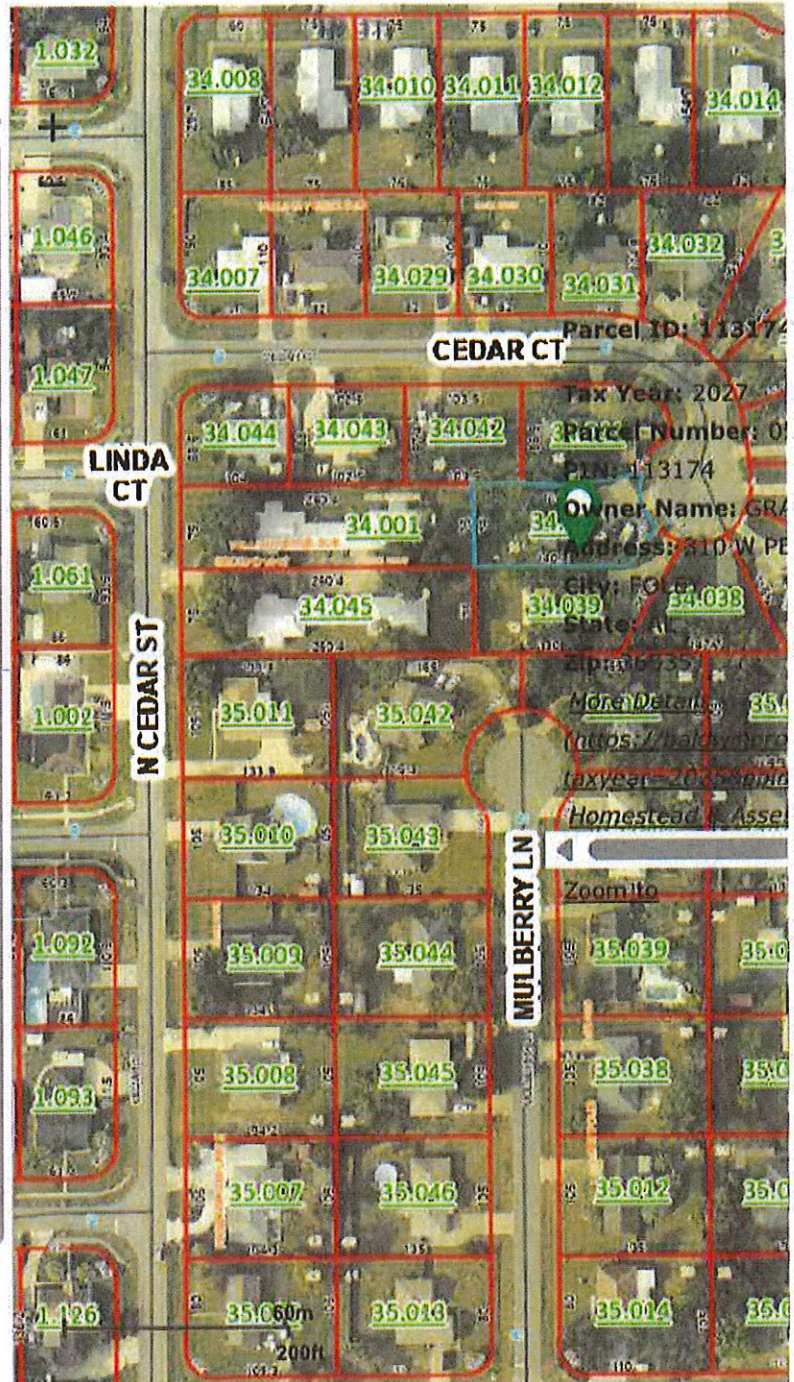

Dear Property Owner

This correspondence constitutes a formal Notice of Violation per section 109.4 of the 2024 International Property Maintenance Code concerning a structure in need of repairs located at the property address of 407 Cedar Ct. In accordance with the City of Foley's adopted code and ordinances, the structure in disrepair on the aforementioned property has been officially deemed "in need of repairs/potentially unsafe" in accordance with section 301.3 of the 2024 International Property Maintenance Code by the Chief Building Official. Consequently, the abatement of this condition(s) is mandated within thirty (30) days following the receipt of this letter. (Refer to the 2024 International Property Maintenance Code sections 301.2, 304.1.1, 304.6, 304.18.1, 304.18.2, 306.1.1 and 308.1). Failure to comply with this notice will result in the issuance of a Citation requiring a mandatory court appearance. Contact me to schedule an on-site meeting to discuss the required abatement actions.

### Additional Compliance Provisions:

- The applicable permits must be obtained for any selected method of abatement, abatement may include repair, rehabilitation, demolition, or removal of the structure, as appropriate.
- Pursuant to section 106 of the International Property Maintenance Code (2024), any determination issued by the Building Official is subject to the right of appeal. • Pursuant to sections 107.3 and 111.3 of the International Property Maintenance Code (2024), any action undertaken by the City of Foley shall constitute a charge against the real estate upon which the structure is situated, thereby establishing a lien upon said real estate.

In accordance with the City of Foley Environmental Department, the following violations apply.

- Ordinance number 1066-08 for Public Nuisance, accumulation of junk, trash and debris.

**Ordinance Definitions:**

**Junk**-Any vehicle or vehicle parts, junked vehicle, rubber tires, appliances, dilapidated furniture, machinery, equipment, building material or other items which are either in a wholly or partially rusted, wrecked, junked, dismantled or inoperative condition.

**Litter**-All garbage, refuse, uncontainerized manmade solid waste, including but not limited to, paper, plastic, diapers, cigarette butts, bottles, cans, glass, crockery, scrap metal, construction materials, rubbish, disposable packages or containers.

**Trash**-Nonputrescible solid wastes consisting of yard clippings, leaves, wood, tree limbs and trunks, bedding, appliances, paper and cardboard, plastics, wood, wrappings, cans and similar materials.

**Certain public nuisances defined:**

- Buildings which are abandoned, partially destroyed, or left in a state of partial construction.
- All land shall be maintained free from any accumulation of garbage, litter, debris, blight or deterioration.
- All land shall be kept free of conditions that constitute or are likely to constitute a fire hazard, or would adversely affect the health or safety of adjacent property owners or occupants of those properties, or would depreciate adjacent property values.
- All land shall be kept free from insect and rodent infestation and noxious pests, or conditions that cause the property to harbor insects, rodents or noxious pests.
- All land shall be maintained so as to prevent the accumulation of stagnant water where such water causes a hazardous or unhealthy condition, breeding area for insects, or erosion of foundation walls.
- All public and private land shall be kept free of abandoned or junk motor vehicles and abandoned or junk watercraft.
