attached are two requests to add to the agenda. One is regarding the memorializing of the Hickory street repaving that the county completed. That project came in at \$94k. Our quote to complete had the county not done it was around \$140k I believe, so doing it through the county was a big dollar savings for us.

The other is a request to go ahead and replace to front of the Hamburg building roof with a metal roof like what is on the rest of it. This ends the water infiltration on teh structure and Chuck has the metal ok'd by the historic board.
