Good afternoon Chief Darby,

I work with Alabama Farmers Cooperative and we have been doing a large grain rescue initiative the last two years. What we have done is partnered with other agribusinesses in the state to be able to raise funds to go towards sponsoring the purchase of grain rescue equipment as well as hold trainings for local fire and rescue units. Baldwin county has a large number of grain bins, both on farms as well as at various businesses such as feed mills. After speaking with the farmers in Baldwin county, we think Foley would be a great, centralized location to put a grain bin rescue tube (that is the name of the equipment), to be able to service Baldwin county if there ever was a grain entrapment scenario. The value of one of the rescue tubes and all the components with it is roughly \$3,500. We hope to be able to schedule a training for your unit on grain rescue entrapment soon.
