A Resolution to reappoint Johnny Inzer and Brock Wells to the Industrial Development Board. Their terms of office expires on September 30, 2018 and they are willing to serve another term.

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama Ethics Commission says that public officials/board members fall under the State Ethics Law, and therefore should have the opportunity to educate themselves regarding this law, and

WHEREAS, the Alabama Ethics Commission has recently developed an online video training of the Alabama Ethics Law, which can be accessed at their website at [www.ethics.alabama.gov](http://www.ethics.alabama.gov), <http://www.ethics.alabama.gov>,> and

WHEREAS, all newly appointed and reappointed board members must submit a copy of their training certification to the City of Foley as a condition to being appointed/reappointed to the boards.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Foley, Alabama, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Reappoints Johnny Inzer and Brock Wells to the Industrial Development Board beginning October 1, 2018 and expiring on October 2, 2024 based on the conditions that they submit a copy of the Alabama Ethics Law certification to the City Clerk to be included in the City's General Files.

**SECTION 2:** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption as required by law.
