A Resolution to Appoint Brandon Nelson as an Alternate Member of the Board of Adjustments and Appeals.

Steve Bailey was appointed as a regular member of the BAA after the resignation of George James leaving an alternate member position vacant. South Baldwin Regional Medical Center Assistant CEO Brandon Nelson is willing to serve as alternate member on the BAA.

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama Ethics Commission says that public officials/board members fall under the State Ethics Law, and therefore should have the opportunity to educate themselves regarding this law, and

WHEREAS, the Alabama Ethics Commission has recently developed an online video training of the Alabama Ethics Law, which can be accessed at their website at www.ethics.alabama.gov, and

WHEREAS, all newly appointed and reappointed board members must submit a copy of their training certification to the City of Foley as a condition to being appointed/reappointed to the boards.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Foley, Alabama, as follows:

SECTION 1: Appoints Brandon Nelson as an alternate member of the Board of Adjustments and Appeals beginning on March 19, 2024 and ending on March 20, 2027 based on the conditions that he submits a copy of the Alabama Ethics Law certification to the City Clerk to be included in the City's General Files.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption as required by law.
