A Resolution Appointing Dr. Brett Taylor to the Library Advisory Board

**DESCRIPTION OF TOPIC:** (who, what, when, where, why, and how much)

Frances U. Lager's has resigned from the Library Advisory Board. Her term expires on June 21, 2025. Brett Taylor would like to fill Ms. Lager's unexpired term.

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama Ethics Commission says that public officials/board members fall under the State Ethics Law, and therefore should have the opportunity to educate themselves regarding this law, and

WHEREAS, the Alabama Ethics Commission has recently developed an online video training of the Alabama Ethics Law, which can be accessed at their website at [www.ethics.alabama.gov](http://www.ethics.alabama.gov), and

WHEREAS, all newly appointed and reappointed board members must submit a copy of their training certification to the City of Foley as a condition to being appointed/reappointed to the boards.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Foley, Alabama, as follows:

SECTION 1: Appoints Dr. Brett Taylor to the Foley Library Advisory Board beginning on October 18, 2021 and ending June 21, 2025 to fill the unexpired term of Frances U. Lager based on the conditions that he submits a copy of the Alabama Ethics Law certification to the City Clerk to be included in the City's General Files.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption as required by law.
