A Resolution to Appoint Mike McGowin and Christina Cooley to the Senior Center Advisory Board

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama Ethics Commission says that public officials/board members fall under the State Ethics Law, and therefore should have the opportunity to educate themselves regarding this law, and

WHEREAS, the Alabama Ethics Commission has recently developed an online video training of the Alabama Ethics Law, which can be accessed at their website at [www.ethics.alabama.gov](http://www.ethics.alabama.gov), <<http://www.ethics.alabama.gov>,> and

WHEREAS, all newly appointed and reappointed board members must submit a copy of their training certification to the City of Foley as a condition to being appointed/reappointed to the boards.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Foley, Alabama, as follows:

SECTION 1: Appoints Mike McGowin to the Senior Center Advisory Board beginning July 15, 2024 and ending on October 6, 2024 to fill the unexpired term left by Don Auseon and appoints Christina Cooley to the Senior Center Advisory Board to fill the vacancy left by the resignation of Bill Schaffer beginning July 15, 2024 and ending on July 16, 2027 based on the condition that they submit a copy of the Alabama Ethics Law certification to the City Clerk to be included in the City's General Files.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption as required by law.
