**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BURK-KLEINPETER, INC. PROPOSAL FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES AND AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO EXECUTE AGREEMENT**

Accept Burk-Kleinpeter, LLC. proposal for professional engineering services for the FBE/CR12 offset left turn lanes construction project and authorize Mayor Koniar to execute the agreement contingent upon ALDOT approval. The Task 1 fees would be funded from HSIP 400-3020-5139 and the Task 2 fees would be from the FBE Intersection Improvements (\$300K 'pending' in plan for FY19). Proposal for Task 1 is \$32,700 (10% matching) and Task 2 is \$88,200.

WHEREAS, The proposal included Task 2, professional engineering services for intersection and signal upgrade improvements in the amount of \$88,200.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Foley, Alabama, as follows:

SECTION 1: Accepts Burk-Kleinpeter, LLC.'s proposal for professional engineering services for the FBE/CR12 offset left turn lanes construction project.

SECTION 2: Appropriates \$88,200 for Task 2, professional engineering services for intersection and signal upgrade improvements under Account No.400-3020-5139 R41 CONST.

SECTION 3: Authorizes Mayor Koniar to execute the agreement with Burk-Kleinpeter, LLC for professional engineering services contingent upon ALDOT approval.

SECTION 4: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption as required by law.
