A Resolution to Appoint a New Member to the Housing Authority Board.

### **DESCRIPTION OF TOPIC:** (who, what, when, where, why, and how much)

Juanita Houston has resigned from the Housing Authority Board and there is a need to fill her position.

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama Ethics Commission says that public officials/board members fall under the State Ethics Law, and therefore should have the opportunity to educate themselves regarding this law, and

WHEREAS, the Alabama Ethics Commission has developed an online video training of the Alabama Ethics Law, which can be accessed at their website at [www.ethics.alabama.gov](http://www.ethics.alabama.gov), and

WHEREAS, all newly appointed and reappointed board members must submit a copy of their training certification to the City of Foley as a condition to being appointed/reappointed to the boards.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Foley, Alabama, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Appoints George Parker to the Housing Authority Board beginning July 16, 2019 and ending on July 17, 2024 based on the conditions that he/she submits a copy of the Alabama Ethics Law certification to the City Clerk to be included in the City's General Files.

**SECTION 2:** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption as required by law.
