A Resolution to Appoint Two New Members to the Museum Archive Board.

John Cobb and Becky Longshore resigned from the Museum Archive Board on July 6, 2020. The Museum Archive Board voted unanimously to appoint Robert Holiday and Clarence Baber to fill the vacancies left by Mr. Cobb and Mrs. Longshore.

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama Ethics Commission says that public officials/board members fall under the State Ethics Law, and therefore should have the opportunity to educate themselves regarding this law, and

WHEREAS, the Alabama Ethics Commission has recently developed an online video training of the Alabama Ethics Law, which can be accessed at their website at <u>www.ethics.alabama.gov</u>, <<u>http://www.ethics.alabama.gov</u>, and

WHEREAS, all newly appointed and reappointed board members must submit a copy of their training certification to the City of Foley as a condition to being appointed/reappointed to the boards.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Foley, Alabama, as follows: SECTION 1: Appoints Robert Holiday and Clarence Baber to the Museum Archive Board beginning July 6, 2020 and ending on July 7, 2023 to fill the vacancies left by the resignations of John Cobb and Becky Longshore and based on the conditions that they submit a copy of the Alabama Ethics Law certification to the City Clerk to be included in the City's General Files.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption as required by law.
