A Resolution Accepting Award of Alabama Historical Commission (AHC), FY2018-19 Certified Local Government (CLG) Grant for Training.

SECTION 3: Approves the appropriation of \$7,500 for the Grant Revenue and \$12,500 for the

training expense in the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget.
