NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Foley, Alabama, as follows:

SECTION 1: Reappoints Ira Bates to the Foley Housing Authority Board beginning September 17, 2018 and ending on September 18, 2023 based on the conditions that he submits a copy of the Alabama Ethics Law certification to the City Clerk to be included in the City's General Files.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption as required by law.
